The team list should be submitted by the respective house Mistress/Master to the event in charge teacher one day before the tournament. Final names can be decided by the house from name given one the day of the event.

Instructions Inter house Cricket Tournament. 11 a side:

1. The tournament will inaugurate on 24th March, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. in Northern Park.
2. Each house must choose at least 15 boys participation.
3. Game format 24th March 16, all houses will play 10 overs limited & break will be for 15mins, 28th March, 16 & 29th March 16, 20 over limited & break will be 30mins.
4. Play will be played with Douse ball.
5. Chucking is not allowed.
6. All batsmen must put on helmets, gloves and pads and other necessary things.
7. All the players must put on their house dress.
8. All the match will be played on cricket ground.
9. All the players must take their equipment's with them on the playground.
10. A briefing on the rules and regulations shall take place before start the tournament, during the recess in the sports room.
11. During the play the umpire supreme authority for any decision.
12. Each win loss will fetch 2, & 0 point for the house. In case of match is draw each team will be rewarded by 1 point.
13. Maintain sports man spirit.
14. Each house must provide at least one official scorer.
15. Ideally there should be a coordinator from each house present who could be a captain, prefect, teacher or house leader.

TECHNICAL DETAILS: RULES & REGULATIONS :-

1. Duration of the match :

All league matches will commence as per fixture.

24th Mar16 (Thursday) Each innings will be of 10 overs duration with an innings break of 15 minutes.

25th Mar16 & 26th Mar16 (Monday & Tuesday) each innings will be of 20 overs duration with an innings break of 30 minutes.

2. Exchange of players list and toss :

10 minutes before the start of the game, captain of both the teams shall exchange their respective list of players in the presence of the umpires.

3. Number of overs to be bowled :

No bowler shall bowl more than 4 overs in an inning or one fourth of the total over of the inning.

4. Penalty for failing to bowl scheduled number of over's :

The fielding side must finish bowling the quota of 20 overs within 100 minutes respectively.

However if the fielding side fails to complete their quota within the given time the batting side will be awarded penalty runs calculated as :

2 X (RUN RATE OF THE BATTING SIDE) X (NO. OF OVERS BOWLED SHORT).

5. Tie match :

In the event of a tie a super over will decide the fate of the match.

6. Limitation of on side fielders :

At the instant of the bowlers delivery there shall not be more than four fielders, other than the wicket-keeper, on the leg side of the batsman. In the event of infringement of this law by the fielding side the umpire shall signal **No Ball**.

7. Power Play and Free Hit :

There shall be no power play overs but a free hit be awarded for a front foot **No Ball** call.
