Students after their ICSE Examination have the opportunity to pursue further studies in the ISC Section of the school situated at 5 Elgin Road. The ISC section raises the bar in terms of infrastructure & soft skills. The entire premises is airconditioned. It makes use of the latest technology. One computer per student has ong been the norm. The computers have high-speed internet connection and surfing is free for the students, under the supervision of teachers.

A lot of emphasis is given to co-curricular activities. Dance classes are organised under the guidence of expert choreographers. Special facilities for Fashion Designing are provided. Exchange programmes are encouraged to provide an enriching experience for our students. The ISC section also boasts of a canteen which serves wholesome & nutritious food.

It encourages leadership skills and confidence and provides students with a sense of achievement. BRIEF HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

In 1928, a group of Gujarati businessmen who had migrated from Gujarat and settled in Bhawanipur and had adopted Kolkata as their 'Karam Bhoomi', felt the need of starting a school to impart and preserve the Gujarati language, culture and values. Thus was born The Bhawanipur Gujarati School in a rented building at 7 Elgin road and later at 7 Allenby Road. Next 30 years the school saw an increase in the number of students and the introduction of English as a subject. By 1956 the school was able to purchase land at 12B Heysham Road and also construct a building which was inaugurated on Vasant Panchami in 1956. Two years later the school got affiliated to Board of Secondary Education West Bengal and in 1960 the school sent its first batch of students to appear in the West Bengal Higher Secondary Examination. During this period, the school was functioning as two units namely Shree ShreeLaxmi Narayan Deo Trust Primary School which later came to be renamed as Blossoms, for primary education at Elgin Road/Allenby Road while the The Bhawanipur Gujarati School catered to higher education at its present location 12B Heysham Road.

During the year 1968 name of the school was changed to J J Ajmera High School in honour of the benefactors of the school during this period. Next 30 years the school progressed in leaps and bounds and also opened its doors for non Gujarati students also. The JJ Ajmera High School continued to send students to West Bengal Higher Secondary Examination and since 1976 the exam came to be known as the Madhyamik Pariksha. 1996 saw the school building being renovated from two stories to a four story building, which allowed the shift of Primary Section from Elgin Road to the 12B Heysham Road premises.

On the demand of the community a need was felt to offer contemporary education so that students were able to fit in the modern environment. This led to the thought of affiliating the school with modern out looking board of examination like the Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE), New Delhi. The school in 1998 got itself affiliated to the Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE), New Delhi under the new name of The Bhawanipur Gujarati Education Society School.

Walking hand in hand with global scenario the need of the hour was introduction of computer technology in teaching of all subjects. The year1998 saw the teachers being trained in this field so that they could help the students. All the teachers were provided with a Laptop to facilitate their work and till date all teachers continue to be equipped with individual Laptops. Two computer labs were renovated to be on virtual LAN with the capacity of 40 desktops, were provided to the students. Each individual student had access to his/her own machine which was very uncommon in those days for any school.

In the year 2010, modern technology was introduced and consequently smart boards were put up in every class room with Educomp modules assisting the education enrichment process. Having built up a strong infrastructure for Academics, the management focussed on the holistic education for the students of the school. This approach to give importance to extra co curricular activities resulted in construction of a new annex building consisting of three floors, in the year 2013, totally dedicated and custom built for activities of sports, music, cookery etc. in the each of the three floor halls. The success of our students in the ICSE examination has been consistently appreciable. The aim of our school is to provide all round education to our children, walking hand in hand with modern technology. The school is scaling new heights every day and the path ahead is waiting to be tread in bold steps to keep abreast with the paradigm shift. Today the school not only admits students of Gujarati origin but has its door open to students from all type of origin and has an absolute cosmopolitan ambience.

What we have to learn to do, we learn by doing.


Students have at their disposal, well-equipped laboratories, library and computer labs.

COMPUTERS are introduced at the primary school level. At The Bhawanipur Gujarati Education Society School, we encourage children to use the computer as an integrated part of the curriculum to enhance and develop classroom activities. All children have supervised access to the internet and e-mail. All class rooms are provided with interactive smart boards with multimedia content.

THE LIBRARY is the focus of our school's reading, research and information-gathering activities. It is well stocked with variety of books on various subjects, fiction and non-fiction besides newspapers, dailies and periodicals. The school encourages its students to inculcate a habit of regular reading.

THE LABORATORIES provide the students the opportunity to conduct their experiments. The everwidening horizon of the student's knowledge is further enhanced by means of the well-equipped science laboratories with instruments and apparatus appropriate to the unique needs of their respective disciplines.

The school anticipates the future needs and requirements of a global citizen and always keeps itself abreast of the very latest in technology to fashion it for the purpose of education. We boast of multiple laboratories equipped with the latest computers having high-end configuration. The computers are all networked and have high-speed internet connection. All the teachers are equipped with laptops and the school premises are enabled with Wi-Fi.



HEALTH AND HYGIENE

In this school, Health and hygiene takes precedence, and towards this end, care is taken to maintain washroom sanitation. For drinking purpose, provision of central water filtration system supplies filtered water through coolers on each floor.

The learning environ in the school is made conducive by prioritizing the comfort of students. So, each classroom and all the activity halls have been air-conditioned. Centralised purified cold drinking water, spotlessly clean surroundings with sterile toilets, corridors and classrooms ensure the highest quality health standards.



SECURITY AND SAFETY

A vigilant security system with CCTVs is installed in the school for round-the-clock safety. Everyone entering the school premises will be recorded on CCTV surveillance. All the classrooms, halls, laboratories, library and even the corridors are equipped with CCTV cameras.



Feel happier within yourself and more contented with life By exploring past and present circumstances, it can open up new possibilities and take control of your lifestyle. Find yourself and be yourself!




























WE YEARN TO SEE YOU LEARN

ADMISSION POLICY

The objective is to ensure that the admission procedure is non-discriminatory, rational and transparent so that the children and their parents are not subjected to admission tests and interviews in order to decide the admission.

Starting from the admissions to the Academic Session 2011-2012 the school admission policy has been based on the under mentioned guidelines for all categories:

No capitation fee of any kind to be paid to any one in connection with the admission to the school. At the entry level, that is at Pre – primary and Class 1 admission, no screening procedure will be followed either for the child or parents.

At the entry level no profiling of the child based on parental educational qualification will be done.

From Class 1 onwards no screening procedure will be adopted, however all candidates are advised to take the counselling sessions as per school guidelines.

All candidates seeking admission above the entry points of Pre Primary will undergo a counselling session to make them aware of the school, its activities and academic requirements. At the same time the school would familiarize itself with the students to understand the degree of support required to cope with the existing class levels, to be able to give a conducive environment for the overall development of the child. Also as a guide for the assessment of the learning process, present and future, there after arm the school to put into practice continuous and comprehensive evaluation of teacher and student learning.

Last date for payment is given in the notice for admission & the challans generated. Admission stands automatically cancelled if payment is not made by the last date as declared. No claim for admission can be made on account of late payment.

The School fees cover twelve calendar months and have to paid on a quarterly basis in advance. No reduction is made for vacations, holidays or broken periods. There is no bar to payment of yearly fees in one instalment at the beginning of the Academic year.

- 1. Fees and other charges once paid are not refundable.
- 2. Students will not be allowed to appear in the examination if the dues are not cleared.
- 3. A late fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged for payment after the due date for the 1st week and thereafter Rs. 35/- will be charged per week or part thereof. (Days will be calculated on a continuous basis to include closed days & holidays) The late fees figures will be reflected in the challans of the subsequent quarters. Fees will not be collected on Bank Holidays. All late fees to be paid before collection of Annual Evaluation Progress Reports.
