THE INSTITUTION

The school being a center of examination for Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi, students of The BGES School appear for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education, New Delhi (ICSE), at the school itself.

The medium of instruction is English.

The School is divided into two sections:

- (i) Nursery to Class IV Primary
- (ii) Classes V to X Secondary

Students after their ICSE Exam have the opportunity to take up further studies in the ISC Section of the school located at 5 Elgin Road and for the have the opportunity to come out as graduates or post graduates from the BESC. The ISC section raises the bar, both in terms of infrastructure and soft skills. The entire premisess is airconditioned. The very latest in educational technologies are implemented here. One computer per student has long been the norm. The computers have high-speed internet connection and surfing is free for the students. At BESC, we provide a world-class campus experience in the heart of Kolkata, with temperature controlled and wifi enabled classrooms, free surfing stations interspersed throughout campus, a spacious cafeteria and common rooms with indoor games facilities. Our well-stocked library, with nearly 15,000 holdings and several internet-enabled computers, is designed to meet all our students' research needs and more. We also have a Career Opportunities Cell with specialist counsellors from all streams of study.

A lot of emphasis is given on co-curricular activities. Classes for dance are undertaken under the guidance of expert choreographers. Special facilities for Fashion Designing are provided to the students. Tie-ups with reputed institutes are there to enrich the learning experience.

ADMISSION POLICY

The objective is to ensure that the admission procedure is non-discriminatory, rational and transparent. Also that the children and their parents are not subjected to admission tests and interviews in order to decide the admission. Starting from the admissions to the Academic Session 2011-2012 the school admission policy has been based on the under mentioned guidelines for all categories:

No capitation fee of any kind to be paid to any one in connection with the admission to the school at the entry level, that is at Pre – primary and Class 1 admission. No screening procedure will be followed either of the child or the parents. At the entry level, no profiling of the child based on parental educational qualification will be done. From Class 1 onwards no screening procedure will be adopted. However, all candidates are advised to take the counseling sessions as per school guidelines.

All candidates seeking admission in Class 1 and above will undergo a counselling session to make them aware of the school, its activities and academic requirements. At the same time the school would familiarize itself with students to understand the degree of support required to cope with the existing class levels. Also to be able to give a conducive environment for the overall development of the child. The counseling session provides a guideline for the assessment of the learning process, present and future. It assists the school to put into practice continuous and comprehensive evaluation of teacher and student learning process.

Last date for payment is given in the notice for admission/ announced at the time of granting admission. Admission stands automatically cancelled if payment is not made by the last date as declared. No claim for admission can be made on account of late payment.

Students have at their disposal, well-equipped laboratories, library and computer labs.

Computers are introduced from the pre-primary classes. The school premises was recently augmented with computers being re-located across two labs, with an overall capacity of 40 computers each. The high-tech computer lab is available to for all students, with dedicated ISDN connectivity.

The use of computers in the Primary School is continuing to develop. This allows students to gain knowledge and understanding of the appropriate use of technology in the context of their subjects. At The BGES School, we encourage children to use the computer as an integrated part of the curriculum to enhance and develop classroom activities. All children have supervised access to the internet and e-mail. The school has a well-developed web site.



The Library is the focus of our school's reading, research and information-gathering activities. It is well stocked with a variety of more than 3000 books on various subjects, fictions and non-fiction besides newspapers, dailies and periodicals. The school encourages its students to inculcate a habit of regular reading.





The **laboratories** provide the students an opportunity to conduct their experiments. The ever-widening horizon of the student's knowledge is catered to by means of the well-equipped science laboratories with instruments and apparatus appropriate to the unique needs of their respective discipline.

The school anticipates the future today and hence keeps itself abreast of the very latest in technology to fashion it for the purpose of education. We boast of multiple laboratories equipped with the latest computers which have high-end configuration. The computers are all networked and have high-speed internet connection. All the teachers are equipped with laptops and the school premises are Wi-Fi enabled.

The school takes an enlightened and positive approach encouraging students to participate in the non-competitive International Award, where character building through self-improvement is the ultimate goal.


The main objectives of the International Award For Young People are:


