Welcome to The Bhawanipur Gujarati Education Society School, an institution for learning that has re-defined Education in the heart of the city of Kolkata. BGES School has been well received among parents ever since it was established in 1928.

Our School is a caring and friendly place where children can grow and learn in a secure, creative and friendly environment – it is also a happy one! Staff, pupils, parents get on well and work together.

We believe that an all-round education is important for development and we are determined to do our very best for every child in the school. Children have access to a high quality education, together with opportunities for creative, sporting and cultural activities.

School life, our discipline and our expectations of all members of the school community, staff and pupils alike, is based on hard work and enthusiasm.

We believe that children are born with the capacity to be creative and that we have the responsibility of ensuring that children's individual creativity is nurtured. We aim to build creativity into the school's curriculum, to provide a stimulating physical environment and to work with outside partners to enrich learning including valuable inspects from visitors to school as well as outside visits. We make purposeful links between subjects to enhance teaching and learning for all children.

Conducive ambience for learning teaching is created by the following facilities in the school such as:

- Clean and hygenic toilets on each floor girls & boys separately.
- All classrooms are Air-Conditioned.
- Airy and well lit classrooms.
- Centralised filtered cold drinking water.
- Two AV multipurpose halls.
- Games room with sports and gym equipments.
- Well equipped science labs.
- Two computer labs, with ISDN connections, facilitating a computer student ratio of 1:1.
- Play toys and furniture for pre primary.
- Only white boards / silicon black boards in all class rooms.

Infrastructural facilities are upgraded regularly to provide students with an ideal learning ambience.

The school being a center of examination for Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi Students of The BGES School appear for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education, New Delhi (I.C.S.E.). at the school itself.

The medium of instruction is English.

The School is divided into two sections:

- (i) Lower Nursery to Class IV Primary
- (ii) Class V to Class X Secondary

Students after their ICSE Examination have the opportunity to take up their further studies in the ISC Section of the school situated at 5 Elgin Road. The ISC section really raises the bar both in terms of infrastructure and soft skills. The entire premises are airconditioned. The very latest in educational technologies are implemented here. One computer per student has long been the norm. The computers have high-speed Internet connection and surfing is free for the students.

A lot of emphasis is given on co-curricular activities. Classes for dance are undertaken under the guidance of expert choreographers. Special facilities for Fashion Designing are provided to the students. Tie-ups with reputed institutes are there to enrich our students further.

The ISC section is catered to by an in-house canteen which serves wholesome and nutritious food.

The Bhawanipur Gujarati Education Society guides and governs the school. It helps the students identify their personal strengths and abilities. It encourages leadership skills and confidence and provides students with a sense of achievement. The Society provides a quality-learning environment, which promotes the best possible educational, social, cultural and recreational development of the individual.

The society's aim is that all students will receive an education, which enhances their learning, builds on their needs and respects their dignity. It also seeks to challenge students to achieve personal standards of excellence and to reach their full potential, while at the same time encouraging them to live and work co-operatively with others right from infancy to adulthood.

At The B G E S School, we encourage children to use the computer as an integrated part of the curriculum to enhance and develop classroom activities. All children have supervised access to the internet and e-mail..

The Library is the focus of our school's reading, research and information-gathering activities. It contains several books, fiction and non-fiction, as well as a wide range of reference material.

The laboratories provide the students the opportunity to conduct their experiments. The ever-widening horizon of the student's knowledge is cate to by means of the well-equipped science laboratories



There is also a mid yearly magazine - "Beyond Classroom", which gives form and expression to the Students' latent talents and creative skills.






The school takes an enlightened and positive approach encouraging students to participate in the non-competitive International Award, where character building through self-improvement is the ultimate goal.


The main objectives of the International Award For Young People are:

Students of BGESS visit the St Joseph's Home For The Aged every Monday to serve lunch to the residents. Additionally, the children serve lunch and spend time with the aged while they eat. Prior to leaving the premises, all utensils and the kitchen is cleaned.

This social service programme has opened the gates of our school to the under-previliged children and enables them to gather basic education. Children belonging to the low-income group and residing in the Bhawanipur area are absorbed into this programme. The classes are held twice a week for an hour. The children attending this programme are between the age groups of five and twelve years. Basically the children are taught etiquette and manners, mental and physical hygiene and so on. The curriculum also includes the knowledge of Hindi, English, Mathematics, Art & Craft and Singing. The school also provides them with extra-curricular activities like visiting the BITM, the Alipore Zoo, Nehru Children's Museum and also films in the school.
