To kiss the salty wave of the sea.

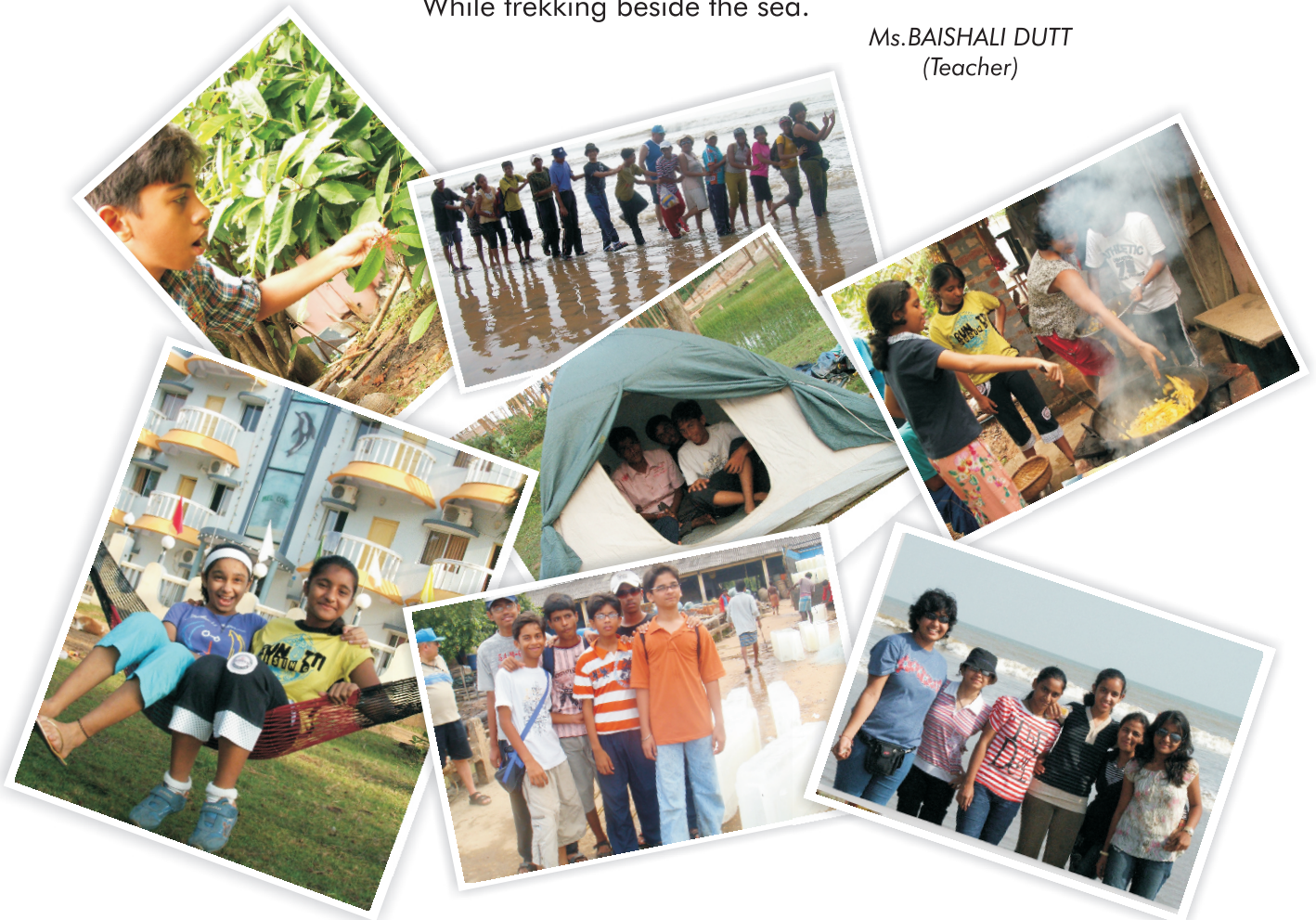
And saw the beach full of red crab

## সৌরভ : বাংলার রাজপুত্র

সৌরভ গাঙ্গুলী ভারতের এমন এক উজ্জ্বল জ্যোতিষ্ক যে বিশ্বের ক্রিকেট প্রেমিকদের কাছে খুবই পরিচিত, আমাদের বাঙালীদের কাছে তিনি দাদা, মহারাজ, প্রিন্স অফ ক্যালকাটা নামেও পরিচিত। সৌরভের ধ্যান, জ্ঞান সবই ক্রিকেট। সৌরভ ১৯৯২ সাল থেকে ভারতের হয়ে আন্তর্জাতিক ক্রিকেট খেলেছেন আর আমাদের দেশকে গর্বিত করেছেন। সময়ের সাথে সাথে তাঁর ভালো খেলার কারণে তাঁকে ভারতের অধিনায়ক পদ দেওয়া হয়। তাঁরই অধিনায়কত্বে ২০০৩ সালে ভারত বিশ্বকাপ ক্রিকেটের ফাইনালে উঠে সম্মানজনক দ্বিতীয় স্থান লাভ করে। তাঁরই সময় ভারতের ক্রিকেট উন্নতির চরম শিখরে পৌঁছেছিল এবং প্রচুর নতুন প্রতিভাবান খেলোয়াড় ভারতের হয়ে খেলার সুযোগ পেয়েছিল।

সৌরভ বিশ্বের অন্যতম সফল ক্রিকেটার ও ভারতের সবথেকে সফলতম অধিনায়ক তার কৃতিত্ব অসীম, তিন ৩১১ টি একদিনের ম্যাচে ১১৩৬২ রান করেছেন আর ১০০ টি উইকেট নিয়েছেন এবং টেস্টে ১১৩ টি ম্যাচ খেলে ৭২১২ রান করেছেন। সম্প্রতি ২০০৮ সালে হঠাৎ সৌরভের আন্তর্জাতিক ক্রিকেট থেকে অবসরের সিদ্ধান্তে তার অনুরাগীরা খুবই হতাশ হয়েছে। তিনি ভারতীয় ক্রিকেটের এক কিংবদন্তী নায়ক এবং ক্রিকেট খেলার ইতিহাসে তার নাম চিরকাল স্বর্ণাক্ষরে লেখা থাকবে।
